Overview

JT10I now offers the health & Safety course leading to the achievement of CSCS Green Card. The industry regulation now requires all candidates wishing to apply for the new CSCS Card to take Level 1 Award in Health & Safety in a Construction Environment Course, as well as pass the CITB Health, Safety and Environment Test to successfully apply for the CSCS Green Labourer Card. This course is designed at entry level for all workers on a construction site either as a labourer or a security officer. Learners can now attend a Level 1 course in Health & Safety and pass a CITB test. Learners will at the end be eligible to apply for a CSCS Green Card.

This course has been validated, accredited and awarded 7 CPD points by the CPD Accreditation Group as meeting sector standards.



Mandatory Requirements

There is no practical element. Learners are required to pass the CITB Health Safety and Environment course to achieve a Level 1 Award in Health and Safety in a Construction Environment (QCF) certificate.
