JT10I now offers the Level 3 First Aid at Work (FAW) course. The FAW is an extensive 3Day level 3 training course which contributes to attaining First Aid at Work Certificate. The course is designed to prepare learners to treat and handle emergency situations where an individual fall ill or is injured. Learners are taught how to operate specialist equipment such as a defibrillator.

From minor wounds or injuries to major falls or disorders, we ensure to cover every aspect of emergency first aid in our course. Our emergency first aid at work covers uncovers all necessary work place incidents and as a result, train the First Aiders to handle any emergency in an effective and efficient manner. Therefore, the course will confirm greater safety with in the workplace and for the employees as well.

This course has been validated, accredited and awarded 21 CPD points by the CPD Accreditation Group as meeting sector standards.



Mandatory Requirements

Due to practical requirements participants must be declared fit before commencement of the course. All participants are required to complete a Health Declaration Form which will be assessed by the course tutor. The tutor may refuse a participant if health concerns are raised. If unsure if any health condition may impact your ability to train, we strongly recommend that you seek advice from your GP or physician prior to attending the course. This course is designed to meet participants of varying fitness levels. We DO NOT accept pregnant candidates on the course.

Certification

This is a two-part competency-based course i.e. theory and practical skills. This course has written assessment which must be achieved at 75%. Don't worry, it's not difficult to pass as there are practice questions. Practical assessment is on-going by the instructor. This certificate is valid for three-year period only, a refresher thereafter, but keeping up to date with changes to policies and procedures is vital to keeping the qualification current.

Participant Note: Booking does not necessarily guarantee a pass. We strive to support learners throughout the course. If a participant fails to meet the required standard, and therefore are not able to pass, they will be referred and may require additional training hours at a reduced rate.
