

Personal licence (APLH)

– 1Day

Overview

JT101 now offers the Level 2 Personal License course. According to the 2003 Licensing Act, it is now legal requirement for premises that serve alcohol, also known as licensed premises, to have a named APLH Licence holder. The APLH Licence, or Award for Personal Licence Holders, allows a holder to authorise the sale of alcohol at licensed premises. The Personal Licence is usually issued by the local council and does not expire. The Personal Licence is designed for bar staff and event managers working in the hospitality industry.

This course has been validated, accredited and awarded 7 CPD points by the CPD Accreditation Group as meeting sector standards.



Mandatory Requirements

To be eligible for an APLH Licence, you must be 18 years of age, have the right to work in the UK and must have passed the APLH Course. Also, you must have a clean DBS Disclosure Check. Having a criminal record does not necessarily disqualify you. The council will assess individual applications.
